Course Summary

In total there are 9 units available for Operatives and 7 for Supervisors. If you wish to add additional units, the additional units are charged at 25 VAT per person, per unit. City and Guilds give all NRSW card holders a six month grace period to take their requalification assessment. However, we will be unable to take any bookings for delegates who want to attend a course where the course start date is within six weeks of the grace period expiry (not card expiry), due to the time that it takes the accrediting body to process the requalification. Delegates need to provide a passport photograph and on the day of training for production of SWQR Cards as well as Photo ID, either the SWQR card, passport or driving licence.

Who Attends

This New Roads and Street Works (NRSW) Requalification Plus course is designed for Operatives or Supervisors that are registered with the Street Works Qualification Register and wish to renew their NRSWA qualification but also require exam preparation and refresher training.

Course content

The NRSW Requalification Plus Training course content includes:
Day 1: Delegates will receive rigorous theory based training and exam preparation designed specifically around the NRSWA Requalification assessment.
Day 2: Delegates will have to sit seven (for Operatives) or six (for Supervisors) written multiple choice exam papers throughout the day under strict exam conditions. Each exam paper must be completed within a strict 30 minute timeframe.
Standard Operative Qualifications: > Location of Underground Services (Unit 1). > Signing, Lighting and Guarding (Unit 2). > Excavation - Operatives (Unit 3). > Reinstatement - Bottom Half - Operatives (Unit 4). > Reinstatement - Top Half - Operatives - (Unit 5). > Bituminous Material - Cold - Operatives (Unit 6). > Modular Pavement - Operatives (Unit 9).
Standard Supervisor Qualifications: > Location of Underground

Services (Unit 1). > Signing, Lighting and Guarding - Supervisors (Unit 10). > Excavation - Supervisors (Unit 11). > Reinstatement - Bottom Half - Supervisors (Unit 12). > Reinstatement - Top Half - Supervisors (Unit 13). > Bituminous Material - Supervisors (Unit 14). > Monitoring re-instatement of Modular Services and Concrete Footways (Unit 16).
