Course Summary

Upon successful completion of the Signing, Lighting and Guarding training course delegates will receive City and Guilds unit accreditation by way of a certificate. Delegates should provide a passport photograph on the day of training for production of SWQR Cards. Delegates should inform their trainer if they have any serious health issues, physical problems, special considerations or are taking any medication, which may create difficulties in undertaking elements of this training course.

Who Attends

This foundation Signing, Lighting and Guarding training course is designed for Operatives and Supervisors who will have to erect or monitor signing, lighting and guarding for work on the roads and highways. This course is specifically designed for Operatives or Supervisors who do not yet have the necessary previous work experience to pass the 1-day Signing, Lighting and Guarding assessment.

The Aim

The Signing, Lighting and Guarding training course aims is to provide Operatives and Supervisors with the skills and knowledge to perform their respective duties when signing, lighting and guarding to the standards prescribed by City and Guilds and in-line with the NRSW Act, in order to safeguard themselves and others.

Knowledge

By the end of the Signing, Lighting and Guarding training course delegates will be able to: > Understand the basic principles of the NRSW Act and standards prescribed by City and Guilds. > Identify and use correct traffic control measures. > Erect and dismantle signing, guarding and lighting safely and in accordance with the supporting Code of Practice. > Correctly and confidently operate the equipment used.

Course content

Signing, Lighting and Guarding training course content includes foundation level training on: > New Roads and Street Works Act > Basic principles of signing, lighting and guarding. > Traffic control measures. > Practical use of the Code of Practice. > Portable traffic lights. > Stop / go boards. > Practical use of equipment.

Methods

A high proportion of discussion and practical training supplemented with video and classroom-based tutorials, model sets and group discussions. Operatives will be assessed by way of practical assessment (previously practiced) and a multiple-choice exam paper along with accompanying paperwork and Supervisors by written assignments and observation exercises as well as a multiple-choice exam paper. A training group may contain only Operatives however, a minimum of 2 Operatives must be available for Supervisors to carry out observation exercises for monitoring signing, lighting and guarding activities.
